

At the first table, collect names and emails of those who attend the trail. Tell them MaxaMom Events is about free monthly events, empowerment, and community within the realm of parenting.

“Happy Halloween superheroes! What are you dressed up as? What’s your mom dressed up as?”

Cool-MaxaMom is here to turn you into super hero (whatever their costume is)!

Along this trail there are four stations and each station is a different super-color. You must fly to each station and tell the gatekeeper one way your mom is your super-hero every day. Like she “flies” you around town or her “powers-you-up” with food.

If you can collect all four colors, you and your MaxaMom can train together and fight courageously as allies from now on.

Here is your super-key (give a wristband). Put all of the colors you collect in here and the gatekeepers at the super-stations will instruct you further. Do not lose your key and give it to the final gatekeeper, as this is necessary to compete your journey. Do you have questions if this is a mission you choose to accept?

Gatekeepers say “do you have your key? And what super-strengths does your mother have?” after the kids answer, say “Wonderful! Here is your color. Now, super kid FLY to the next super-station!” Gatekeepers must stimulate kids if they can’t think of superhero activities that their moms do. In my experience so far, this hasn’t been an issue. Gatekeepers must also be sure that ribbons are secure inside the “key” pipe cleaner so they don’t get carried away in the wind.

They collect four colors and the final “gatekeeper” gives a wristband and helps secure it and also collects the “key.”

People with questions about event and sponsorships should be directed to me. All grownups should leave with a quarter sheet flier, which I will distribute at the primary table. Feel free to give out cards to good opportunities.
